ELLENSBURG, Wash. — The Ellensburg Rodeo has had the pleasure of hosting Sophia Tilley, a 16year old young lady from Yakima, WA, as a singer of the national anthem at our rodeo on more than one occasion. The winner will be decided by fan votes.

Sophia first sang publicly when she was 6 years old at the nationally acclaimed Leavenworth, WA, Christmas Lighting Festival. At age 12 Sophia opened the 2010 Ellensburg Rodeo, with the singing of the National Anthem. She was the youngest singer to open the rodeo in its 83-year history and has returned every year to sing the National Anthem. She regularly performs at regional area wineries, western and rodeo events, community non-profit events, restaurants, weddings, and many other private social events. Sophia enjoys singing a variety of musical styles, although her favorite style of music is country and blues. She plays the acoustical guitar, arch top electric, ukulele, and piano. Currently, Sophia is in the process of recording some of her original music.
