Ellensburg Rodeo payout reaches record

Ellensburg, Wash. — This year's Ellensburg Rodeo is bigger than ever with a record payout projected to be more that The annual rodeo is a Labor Day weekend tradition in Ellensburg, and attracts the top contestants and performers in the country.

"The Ellensburg Rodeo has earned its place as one of the top 10 professional rodeos and we stay there by continually improving our events, attracting the best cowboys, livestock and a payout of over \$500,000," said Ellensburg Rodeo Board President Gene Dana.

The excitement starts on Friday, Sept. 4, and runs through the finals on Monday, Sept. 7. This year's specialty act is the Chariot Outlaws. Announcer Justin McKee and clown JJ Harrison will be back, along with an expanded slate of musical performers at Behind the Chutes, including singer Chance McKinney.

But of course, all of the attention will be on the arena as more than 600 of the nation's top riders, ropers and wrestlers compete.

Highlights:

- The popular Wrangler Xtreme Bulls World Tour, which features more than \$100,000 in prize money, will take place on Saturday, Sept. 5. The top 40 bullriders in the world are vying for the championship, which ends in Ellensburg.
- A new high-stakes event, called the Cinch Shoot-Out, has been added to the schedule this year on Sunday, Sept. 6. Eight contestants compete in highlighted events, with the top four moving to a sudden-death round. Fans will see a champion crowned at the conclusion of the performance. Events include bareback riding, saddle bronc riding, bull riding, team roping (equal money), tie-down roping and barrel racing. The champion of each event will walk away \$10,000 richer.
